
I think there is a bug with waypoints and sharp bends indications


I have this course created in Garmin Connect that has two waypoints called "Merca" and "Castros":



When I load the course, this is what happens:





Explore the screens on the Edge.


The course on the map has a lot of arrows, that seems to indicate the place of the sharp bends, but they are sent as waypoints too.



Following the course appears a new data page with the list of all the waypoints (or the sharp bends), the same arrows as the map.



You have to scroll some times to see the real waypoint "Merca" and its references of time and distance.






The option Course Points is enabled:
